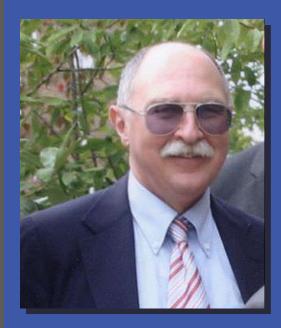

Solving the Mona Lisa Smile, and Other Developments in Visual Micro-Sociology
