Frederick Wherry is the author of *The Philadelphia Barrio* (University of Chicago Press, 2011), *The Culture of Markets* (Polity, 2012), and *Global Markets and Local Crafts* (Johns Hopkins, 2008). He is also co-editor (with Nina Bandelj) of *The Cultural Wealth of Nations* (Stanford University Press, 2011). He has conducted ethnographic research in Philadelphia (USA), Thailand, and Costa Rica. His work examines how the value of places and things is generated, contested, and transformed. And his new research explores how people of color understand and use money. He is currently an Associate Professor of Sociology at the University of Michigan.
